This side event focuses on global sustainable development through social protection and jobs, education transformation, digitalization and public sector capabilities. It aims to enhance human resources for SDGs like SDG 4 and 8 and strengthen sustainable development amidst economic shifts. It will also showcase good practices and discuss efforts led by governments together with other partners and stakeholders, including CSOs, to close the skills gaps, promote inclusion and ensure a diverse and adaptable workforce.

ASPBAE's Regional Policy Coordinator and Lead Policy Analyst, **Rene Raya**, as well as the President of ICAE, **Jose Roberto Guevara**, will be part of the panel that will discuss and highlight skilling practices that alleviate unemployment and enhance social protection.
